

COMMON COUNCIL
REGULAR SESSION
MAY 19, 2014

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in Regular Session on Monday May 19, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Joseph M. Thallemer presided and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS-

DOMESTIC CHICKEN ORDINANCE-

Ordinance #2014-04-01 allowing homeowners to own up to five (5) domestic chickens by amending Chapter Six of the City Code and adding Section 13.10 to Appendix B-Zoning was presented for a second reading. Mayor Thallemer gave an overview as to what had taken place so far with the ordinance and asked Assistant City Planner Tim Dombrosky give a brief review of the amendments added to the ordinance. Mayor Thallemer then opened the floor for comments from the public. Ellen Schwendeman and Sarah Steele spoke in favor of the ordinance while Tony Silveus and Sheila Burner spoke in opposition of the ordinance. After further discussion from the Council, Councilor Grose made a motion to approve Ordinance 2014-04-01, seconded for approval by Councilor Frush, with Councilor Klondaris voting aye and Councilors Call, Dobbins, Smith and Quance voting nay, causing the motion for approval to fail.
