ORDINANCE/TRANSFER OF FUNDS-

CITY-WIDE SPRING CLEAN-UP-

Councilmember Diane Quance gave an update on the Community Clean-Up Week to be held in conjunction with KC Recyclings Environmental Action Week. Councilmember Quance and Councilmember Dobbins have worked on coordinating efforts for the week that will kick off on April 20th when KC Recycling will offer “specials” on items brought in for recycling. April 23rd will be Kids Clean-Up Day for neighborhoods and the special needs classes from the high school will be sprucing up the downtown area. They are encouraging other groups to organize their own clean-up groups during the week as well. The street department will pick up one extra large item from each stop and will also start the Dial-A-Truck program that week.
