

**COMMON COUNCIL  
REGULAR SESSION  
October 18, 2021  
7:00 P.M.**

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in a Regular Session on Monday, October 18, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Joseph M. Thallemer presided and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

**PRESENT:** Council members Cindy Dobbins, Jack Wilhite, Josh Finch, Mike Klondaris, Jerry Frush, and Diane Quance. Also present, Mayor Joseph M. Thallemer, Clerk-Treasurer Lynne Christiansen, City Planner Justin Taylor, Wastewater Treatment Utility Manager Brian Davison, James Vektor, InkFree News reporter Dan Spalding and Times-Union reporter David Slone. City Attorney Scott Reust joined virtually through GoTo Meetings. The meeting was also presented live over the City's website at <https://www.warsaw.in.gov>.

**ABSENT:** Council member Jeff Grose.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Thallemer followed by the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES-**

The minutes from the September 30, 2021 meeting were presented for approval. Motion made by Councilor Dobbins to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Councilor Wilhite, carried by unanimous vote.

**REPORTS/ORAL & WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS-**

1. September 2021 Fund Report.
2. Mayor Thallemer gave a presentation on results of the 2020 Census, noting the following:
  - United States population in 2010 was 308,745,538 and 331,4491,281 in 2020 a 7.3% increase.
  - State of Indiana population in 2010 was 6,483,802 and 6,785,528 in 2020 a 4.6% increase.
  - Kosciusko County's population in 2010 was 77,538 and 80,240 in 2020 a 3.7% increase.
  - City of Warsaw's population in 2010 was 13,559 and 15,804 in 2020 a 16.6% increase.
3. Councilor Dobbins presented a list of non-profit funding recommendations from the Non-Profit Committee.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS-**

**2022 BUDGET AND TAX RATE APPROVAL ORDINANCE-**

Ordinance #2021-10-01, Appropriations and Tax Rates for 2022, was presented for approval. After discussion, Councilor Quance made a motion to approve the Ordinance on second and final reading, seconded by Councilor Dobbins, carried by unanimous vote.

**NEW BUSINESS-**

**TRANSFER RESOLUTION/B&P-**

City Planner Justin Taylor presented Resolution #2021-10-01. The Resolution transfers a total of \$20,000.00 within the Building and Plan budget in order to purchase a new vehicle for the department. Motion made by Councilor Dobbins to approve Resolution #2021-10-01, seconded by Councilor Klondaris, carried by unanimous vote.

**TRANSFER RESOLUTION/STORMWATER/CCD-**

Resolution #2021-10-02 was presented for approval. The Resolution transfers a total of \$93,456.85 within the Cumulative Capital Development (CCD) Fund for the McKinley Storms Sewer Improvements. Motion made by Councilor Quance to approve Resolution #2021-10-02, seconded by Councilor Frush, carried by unanimous vote.

**OTHER MATTERS-**
