

## Campground Rules

The following are general rules for your stay at Pike Lake Campground. This list is not meant to be all-inclusive; the Camp Manager may make decisions based on the present circumstances. We hope you enjoy your stay at our campground and come to visit us again!

1. Campsites are marked on the asphalt. Please stay within your rented space. The use of another site may result in extra charges.
2. Campsites must be kept clean and neat. All trash must be contained in plastic bags and placed at the edge of the road or in the provided dumpster. Park employees will pick up the trash weekdays until 2:00 PM and weekends until 8:00 AM. After this time, please place trash in the dumpster and not at the roadside.
3. Children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian to the restrooms and showers.
4. Absolutely no laundry or dishes can be done in the restrooms or showers. Hot water is not permitted to be carried out of the restrooms or showers.
5. Dogs and other pets must always be kept on a leash and kept quiet. Animal waste must be picked up and disposed of by its owner. There are no pets permitted in the restrooms or showers. Campers may play with their dogs in the grassy area by the Firemens' Building fence providing they clean up after themselves.



6. Alcoholic beverages must be kept on your own campsite.
  7. Vehicle parking is permitted on sites that are occupied but must remain on the millings and not parked on the lawn or impeding the roadway. Absolutely no parking of vehicles on vacant lots or empty rented lots. Additional parking is provided along the split-rail fence in the beach parking lot. All other inquiries are at the discretion of the Camp Manager. Boat trailer parking is in the "Back 40" or, if approval is obtained by the Camp Manager, along the west fence of the Firemens' Building.
  8. The camping fee is for one family only. Overnight guests must register in the camp office and pay \$3.00 per night. Maximum of 6 visitors allowed from 8 AM to 10 PM. All visitors must exit the campground no later than 10 PM.
  9. No tent-only camping on any site. One tent may be allowed on an occupied site for children if approved by the Camp Manager.
  10. Be considerate of your neighbors. Please do not cut through their site or make excessive noise. Quiet time begins at 11 PM and is strictly enforced.
- After hours fishing permits allowing campers to fish on Pike and Center lakes can be obtained at the Parks Office, located at 123 E. Fort Wayne Street, Warsaw, during business hours.
- Refund Policy:** No refunds for reservations canceled 30 days or less prior to reservation date. Reservations canceled 30+ days prior will be refunded less a \$40.00 cancelation fee and card service charges.
- Check in:** 1 – 7 PM | **Check out:** 12 PM (noon)
- NO SUBLETTING OF SITES ALLOWED.**
